EIA, EHV, strangles, NWS, ALHT, vesicular stomatitis and emerging parapox

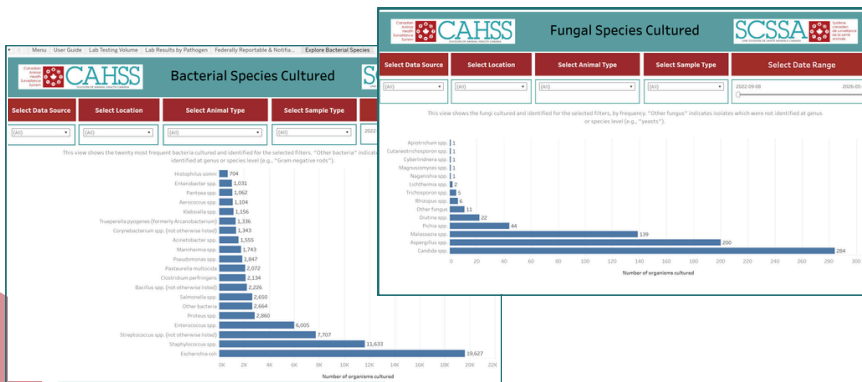
